

Canine Bordetella Vaccine Release Form

Canine Bordetella is a very contagious disease caused by bacteria. The bacteria that cause bordetella can be easily transmitted through the air. The disease mostly affects dogs who are in a confined space with other dogs. Kennels, grooming shops, and pet shops are most commonly affected.

Symptoms of canine bordetella normally appear one week after the dog has been infected. The most common symptom of the disease is a severe cough that can last several weeks if not treated.

Crab Orchard Veterinary Services recommend that your dog be vaccinated 7-10 days prior to boarding with us. The vaccine needs to be administered every 6 months if your dog is in a boarding facility or is groomed often.

Crab Orchard Veterinary Services will not be held responsible if your dog contracts canine bordetella if not properly vaccinated. We will not be responsible for any costs incurred for treatment of this disease.
